Techniques - Test data generation, Test oracles, Metrics, Testing theory, Empirical studies

Systems - Embedded and real-time software, Concurrent software, Web applications

We invite **original, high-quality research papers and industrial experience papers** in all areas of software testing, verification and validation. We also invite **proposals for workshops** to be co-arranged with the conference.

A special issue of Software Testing, Verification, and Reliability (Wiley) will be published featuring the best papers from the conference.

The conference will be held in the [Westin Tabor Center](#), centrally located in downtown Denver. Denver is the capital of the state of Colorado with flights to all major hubs in USA, Europe and Asia.
